Course Description: Along with diverse ethnic groups, Britain has peoples of distinct nationalities, which introduces various and complex national identity potentialities and formations. This course explores nationality and national identit(y)ies in Britain through a variety of texts, films and documentaries. Hence, this course analyses the definition(s) of nationality and Britain's multiple national identities in a comparative context. It aims to examine the British, the English, the Irish, the Scottish and the Welsh to identify and discuss the constituents of their respective national identities vis a vis nationalism and multiculturalism in Britain as such configurations are experienced and represented in literature and relevant texts and the media.
